WHAT'S INVOLVED

You will undertake a free four week full time training course designed to provide you with the skills and knowledge to prepare you for full time employment or transition into a paid traineeship. The program includes weekend excursions and work experience. You will live on-site for the duration of the course and receive a certificate of completion.

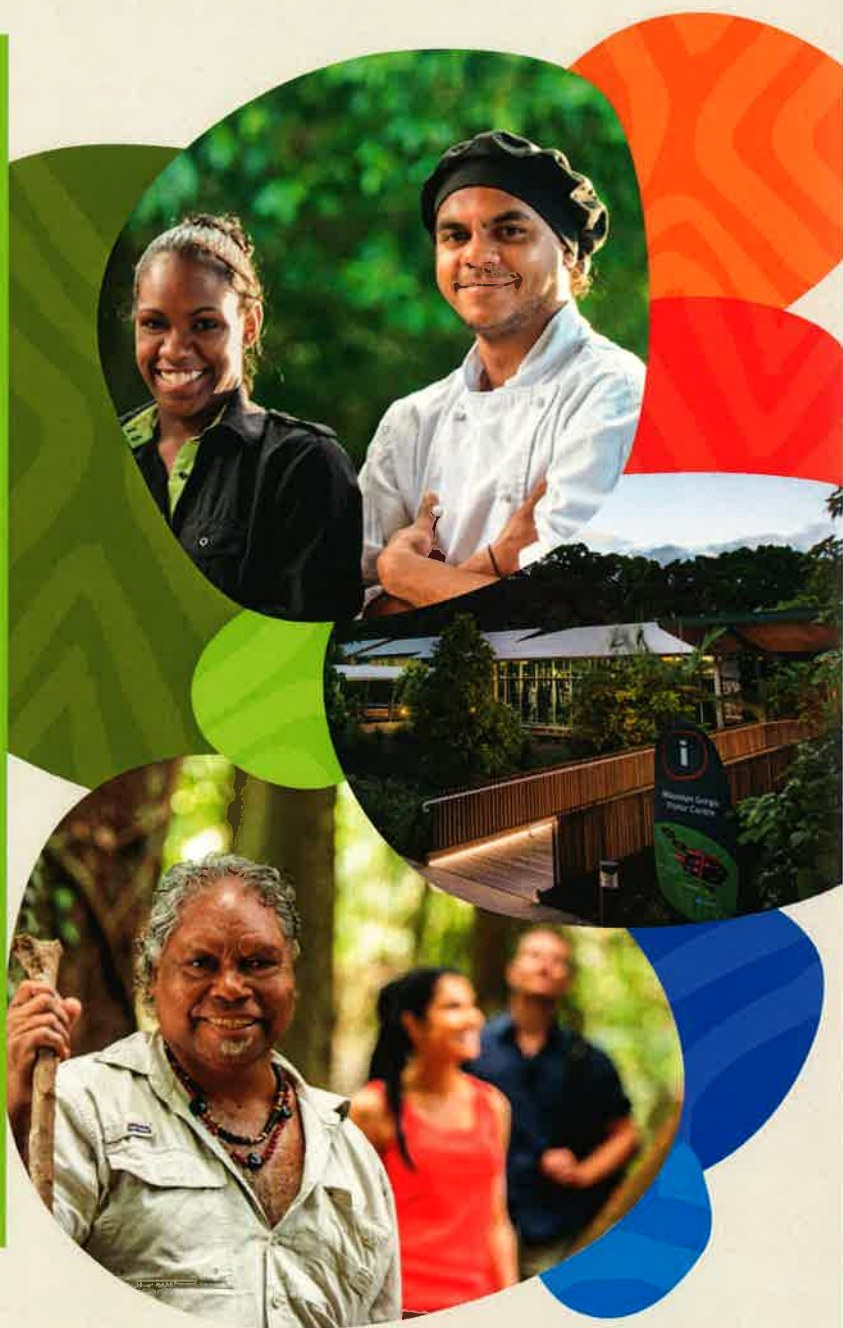
- Assistance with relocation (criteria applies)

- Be eligible for funding assistance with jobactive or a Community Development Program (CDP) provider
